<p>Attendance Expectations and Recording</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● To be counted present for days missed while excluded from school due to one of the following: <i>quarantined due to exposure to COVID-19</i> or <i>self-isolating due to a positive COVID-19 diagnosis and able to do school work</i>, students must submit all assignments required by the teacher by the day they return to school in person. ● Teachers will clearly communicate to parents/guardians of an excluded student (remote) learner what is required for the student to be counted present; students will submit completed assignments for each day of exclusion. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ On the day the student returns to school, the teacher will mark his/her attendance, by the end of the school day, for the days the student was excluded.
<p>Resources/ Platforms</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Students will utilize district-adopted resources (textbooks and digital resources such as i-Ready, Imagine Learning, Achieve 3000, etc.) for each content area. ● There will be continued use of Google Classroom, Zoom, Screencastify, GoGuardian, and Kami, as appropriate. ● Students will engage in their school work using the district-provided Chromebook or Chrome Tablet.
